

DUAL ROLE – BAND COACH/MANAGER FOR SESSION 1 & 2

DUTIES

Dual Role - Band Coach/Band Manager for Session 1 & 2 will:

- Help campers compose a song during band rehearsals (you will be assigned to a band of 5 campers with a co-coach)
- Assist campers during studio recording on Friday
- Provide general supervision and emotional support to the campers in your band at all times during work hours. This means you are responsible for the 5 campers in your band and should know where these campers are at all times during scheduled work hours. If you have 2 coaches per band and one coach needs to step out for a moment, be sure to communicate this to your co-coach.
- Assist with gear movement, room set up for your band before rehearsal begins
- Assist with dismissal of campers at the end of the day, making sure all campers depart with an approved adult
- Attend and participate in discussions at staff debriefing
- Collaborate and communicate effectively with your co-coach and other staff members to role-model healthy interactions
- Provide campers with guidance on daily schedule, emotional support and encourage positive collaboration.
- Be present and involved during Monday morning activities to greet campers, help with way-finding and participate in “morning energizers”/group activity
- Communicate with band coaches/girl power coach if concerns arise over the well-being/behavior of any camper(s) that they are supervising/supporting

REQUIRED EXPERIENCE

Previous experience working collaboratively/co-creating with other musicians, and songwriting/composition experience required. Recording studio experience helpful. Previous experience working with/mentoring children helpful.

As band manager AND a band coach, you may, if desired, alternate with your co-coach in taking an off-site break Monday – Thur. These breaks can occur during Monday's songwriting time and during Tue -Thur's breakout session time in the afternoons. You and your co-coach can work out the specifics but one of you must be in the room with the band during the songwriting on Monday and breakout sessions Tue – Thur.

COMPENSATION/PAY

\$500/wk **\$100 will be deducted from your check for a missed day. \$50 for missed showcase. You will not be docked for one day of illness.

GENERIC ABILITIES/REQUIREMENTS

Band Coaches/Managers for Session 1 & 2 will:

- Demonstrate clarity on/understanding of GRC Mission Statement and ability to uphold during camp day
- Behave in a pleasantly assertive and energetic way with campers and staff
- Demonstrate ability to collaborate with others/be a team player
- Demonstrate good communication skills by
 - resolving conflict in a professional and constructive way
 - accepting constructive feedback and incorporating into job performance
- Work well under stress/stay positive in stressful situations
- Show ability to adapt/be flexible to changes in the daily schedule, job assignments, etc.
- Show respect for campers and fellow staff through timely arrival and communication with supervisors if circumstances arise that prevent timeliness or attendance
- Represent GRC and its staff in a positive light in the community
- Uphold the code of conduct by adhering to policy of no consumption of alcohol/illegal substances during camp/showcases and no smoking on campus or within eyesight of campers
