### **DUTIES**

#### **Art Director job duties include:**

- Planning, preparing and executing arts and crafts activities on the Friday of each camp, which can include things such as:
  - T-shirt cutting/design
  - Band poster design
  - Button making with logos designed by bands
  - Jewelry making with guitar picks
- Working with Executive Director one month before camp to plan and order supplies as needed
- Propose a budget to Executive Director for supplies needed for art
